What Do You Do With the Purchased Animal?

- Designate a slaughter facility from our list. We will deliver the animal and they will call you for exact cutting and wrapping instruction's.
- You make take the animal yourself on Sunday before noon or after 6:00 p.m.
- You may donate the animal back and claim the full tax deduction. We will re-sell the animal with the proceeds benefitting the "4-H Livestock Program" or the "4-H Private Support Fund" (a general fund that benefits all 4-H programs) of Cornell Cooperative Extension of Cattaraugus County 4-H Program.
