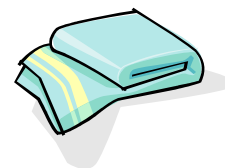


TRAVELING SHOWER BUNDLES

So, you need a convenient way to have all your shower supplies in one place when you travel. This “Traveling Shower Bundle” is just the thing you need.

Supplies:

- Hand Towel (approximately 17 x 30 inches)
- Thread (matching the color of towel)
- Buttons (decorative buttons that show your personality or a theme (sport, flower, hobby))
- Coordinating decorative ribbon
- 1 yard of 1-inch-wide ribbon to use as a fastener (you can use a 2-inch long strip of Velcro if you like)
- Travel sized bottles for shampoo, conditioner, bath wash, and lotion, etc.
- Small comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Rub-on(s) that match your theme/personality and you may want letters do words for the bottles (i.e. Lotion, Shampoo)
- Sewing machine and sewing supplies



Direction:

1. One of the ends of the towel, place the decorative ribbon on the edge and pin down. This will be the trim on the top of the pockets. Stitch the ribbon in place.
2. Lay the towel right side down, placing the embroidered trim edge at the bottom. Fold the length of the bottom edge up to reveal the trim and crate a 7-inch pocket. Pin and then stitch the folded towel together every 3 – 6 inches to crate divided pockets. Note: Before stitching the edges of the first pocket on the right-hand side of the towel, arrange buttons and coordinating ribbon along the edge on (right) side of the towel. This edge will become the top of the rolled-up case. Stitch the desired arrangement of buttons and/or ribbon in place.
3. If you prefer to use ribbon to tie the case, fold the ribbon in half and insert in the stitches when the side edges are joined together to make the last pocket. If you chose a touch fastener (Velcro) to seal the case together, first stitch a scrap of trim to the back of the hook portion of the touch fastener. Insert one edge of this tab halfway down the edge of the towel. Trap the end of the tab in stitches when the side edges are joined together to make the last pocket. To gauge the placement of the loop portion of the touch fastener, insert various items into the finished pockets. When the case is rolled up, position the loop portion to fall under the hook tab and then stitch it in place.
4. Filling your case (bundle), using the rub-on(s) that match your theme, place them on the travel sized bottles where you want them. You will rub on image onto the bottle using the wooden stick them provided in the package. Fill your bottles and place in pockets. Fill other pockets with comb, toothbrush, toothpaste or whatever else you like.

These bundles make great gifts for anyone who travels!! You can also use them on the beach to carry beach supplies (sunglasses, sun lotion, etc.).
