

GOING TO MAKE A POSTER??

1. Design should cover 2/3 of sign area.
2. Lettering should cover 1/3 of area.
3. Balance design with lettering and picture of topic.
4. Must show its point at a glance
5. If color is used, main objects should be bright while lesser points in subdued tones.
6. Be sure colors harmonize. A contrary poster catches the eye but loses its value.

SUGGESTIONS

- ! Know where you want to display posters and be consistent in practicing.
- ! Title poster attractive - includes subject of demonstration and name of demonstrator. It also serves the purpose of covering other posters until information is presented to the audience. Place posters so that title poster will appear on top for summary of demonstration.
- ! Subject matter poster such as enumerating steps involved and use bold type lettering.
- ! Use pointers, know your subject well so you don't need to study posters as you talk.
- ! **PRACTICE..PRACTICE..PRACTICE...**
